

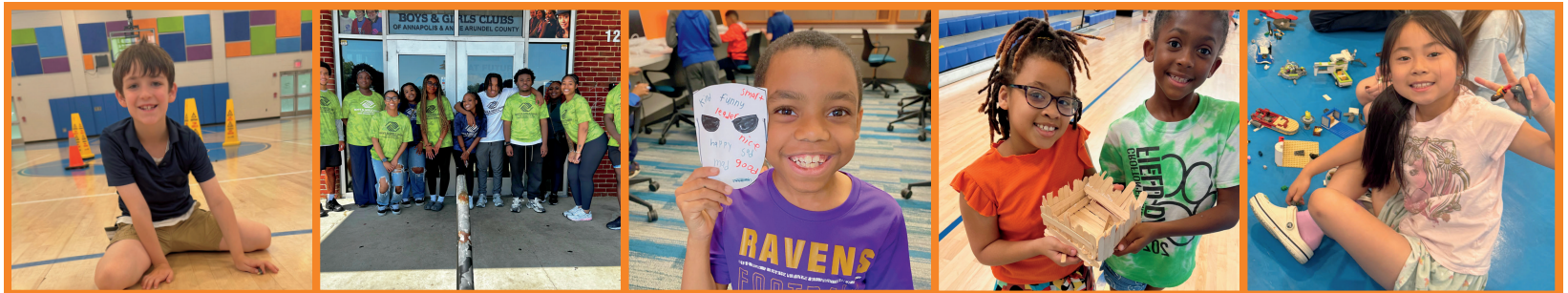
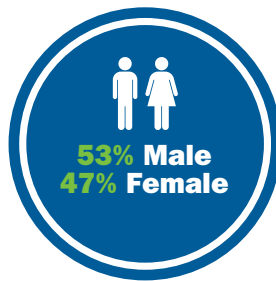

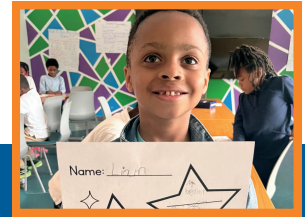
Health & Well-Being

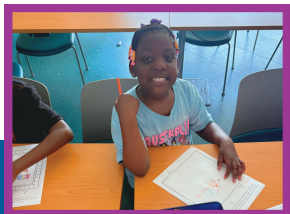
Character & Leadership
